At the end of subtitle H of title VIII, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 8 REPORT ON DEFENSE DEPARTMENT'S LITHIUM
2	SUPPLY CHAIN AND APPLICATIONS FOR FU-
3	TURE ADVANCED MILITARY CAPABILITIES.
4	(a) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than March 1,
5	2026, the Under Secretary of Defense for Acquisition and
6	Sustainment shall submit to the Committee on Armed
7	Services of the Senate and the Committee on Armed Serv-
8	ices of the House of Representatives a report on the De-
9	partment of Defense's current supply and anticipated need
10	for lithium.
11	(b) Elements.—The report required by subsection
12	(a) shall include the following:
13	(1) An assessment of crucial military elec-
14	tronics, communication devices, infrastructure, vehi-
15	cles, and conventional and nuclear weapons infra-
16	structure that utilize lithium compounds, including
17	lithium carbonate, lithium hydroxide, and lithium
18	metals.

1	(2) An assessment of the Department's antici-
2	pated demand for lithium compounds and lithium-
3	based materials for future advanced weapons sys-
4	tems, including unmanned surface, aerial, and un-
5	derwater vessels requiring modular battery systems,
6	and for energy storage solutions to enhance power
7	grid resilience and advance artificial intelligence
8	data center systems.
9	(3) An assessment of potential lithium supply-
10	chain risks that pose a threat to military readiness
11	and the feasibility of leveraging and partnering with
12	commercial industry to strengthen the supply of lith-
13	ium and address identified vulnerabilities.
14	(4) A description of the Department's current
15	and anticipated use of procurement authorities for
16	obtaining domestically processed critical minerals,
17	including lithium.
