

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 117-13**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MOORE OF UTAH**

Add at the end of subtitle B of title XII of division  
A the following:

1 **SEC. 12 \_\_\_\_ . REPORT OF HUMAN RIGHTS VIOLATIONS BY**  
2 **THE TALIBAN AGAINST UNITED STATES CITI-**  
3 **ZENS AND AFGHAN INDIVIDUALS WHO SUP-**  
4 **PORTED UNITED STATES MILITARY AND DIP-**  
5 **LOMATIC EFFORTS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the  
7 date of the enactment of this Act and every 90 days there-  
8 after for two years, the Secretary of State, in coordination  
9 with the Director of National Intelligence and the heads  
10 of other appropriate Federal agencies, shall submit to the  
11 appropriate congressional committees a report on inci-  
12 dents of human rights violations by the Taliban against—

13 (1) United States citizens and their family  
14 members who are not United States citizens, in Af-  
15 ghanistan and other foreign countries; or

16 (2) Afghan individuals and their family mem-  
17 bers who assisted United States military operations,  
18 United States diplomatic operations or program-  
19 ming, or United States development and human

1 rights activities, in Afghanistan and other foreign  
2 countries.

3 (b) MATTERS TO BE INCLUDED.—Each report under  
4 subsection (a) shall include—

5 (1) a detailed description of any incidents re-  
6 ferred to in such subsection that occurred after the  
7 President’s announcement in April 2021 regarding  
8 the implementation of a full withdrawal of United  
9 States troops from Afghanistan by September 11,  
10 2021; and

11 (2) any actions the Taliban has taken to deter  
12 incidents of human rights violations, intimidation, or  
13 harassment against individuals described in such  
14 subsection.

15 (c) FORM.—Each report required by subsection (a)  
16 shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include  
17 a classified annex.

18 (d) DEFINITION.—In this section, the term “appro-  
19 priate congressional committees” means the congressional  
20 defense committees and—

21 (1) the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the  
22 Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence of the  
23 House of Representatives; and

1           (2) the Committee on Foreign Relations and  
2           the Select Committee on Intelligence of the Senate.
