

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-3**  
**OFFERED BY MS. MOORE OF WISCONSIN**

At the end of title V, add the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . MATERNAL MORTALITY OR MORBIDITY STUDY.**

2 (a) **STUDY.**—The Secretary of Health and Human  
3 Services, in collaboration with the Center for Disease Con-  
4 trol and Prevention and in consultation with the Attorney  
5 General, the Director of the Indian Health Service, and  
6 other stakeholders (including community based organiza-  
7 tions), shall conduct a study on the whether victims of  
8 domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalk-  
9 ing throughout the United States are more at risk of ma-  
10 ternal mortality or morbidity as a result of issues related  
11 to domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or  
12 stalking.

13 (b) **REPORTS.**—Not later than three years after the  
14 date of enactment of this title, the Secretary of Health  
15 and Human Services, in consultation with the Attorney  
16 General, the Director of the Indian Health Service, and  
17 other stakeholders (including community based organiza-  
18 tions), shall report to Congress on the study conducted  
19 under subsection (a). The report shall include:

1           (1) An analysis of the extent in which domestic  
2 violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking  
3 result in pregnancy related death.

4           (2) An analysis of the impact of domestic vio-  
5 lence, dating violence, sexual assault or stalking on  
6 access to health care.

7           (3) A breakdown of individuals particularly im-  
8 pacted by domestic violence, dating violence, sexual  
9 assault, or stalking, by race and ethnicity.

10          (4) An analysis of the impact of domestic vio-  
11 lence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking on  
12 Tribal communities and among Native Americans.

13          (5) An assessment of the factors that increase  
14 risks for infant and maternal mortality or morbidity  
15 among survivors of domestic violence, dating vio-  
16 lence, sexual assault, or stalking.

17          (6) Recommendations for legislative or policy  
18 changes to help reduce infant and maternal mor-  
19 tality rates.

20          (7) Best practices to reduce pregnancy related  
21 deaths among survivors of domestic violence, dating  
22 violence, sexual assault, or stalking.

1           (8) Any other information on maternal mor-  
2           tality or morbidity the the Secretary determine ap-  
3           propriate to include in the report.
