2 Section 41601(e) of the Violent Crime Control and
3 Law Enforcement Act of 1994 (34 U.S.C. 12511(e)) is
4 amended by adding at the end the following:

5 "(g) FORENSIC-MEDICAL AND ADVOCACY SERVICES
6 FOR TRIBES INITIATIVE.—

7	"(1) IN GENERAL.—The Attorney General, in
8	consultation with the Secretary of Health and
9	Human Services, shall make grants to eligible enti-
10	ties establish, sustain, or expand programs offering
11	sexual assault medical forensic exams and sexual as-
12	sault victim services in tribal communities.

13 "(2) ELIGIBLE ENTITY.—An eligible entity any
14 of the following:

15 "(A) A State, local, or Federally recog-16 nized tribal government.

17 "(B) An agency of a State, local, or Feder-18 ally recognized tribal government.

19 "(C) A nonprofit organization.

2	which is to provide healthcare, such as a hos-

5	"(3) FUNDING.—Of the amount made available
6	to carry out this section, \$14,000,000 shall be for
7	grants under this subsection.
8	"(4) PRIORITY.—The Attorney General shall
9	give priority to applicants proposing innovative ways
10	of bringing experienced sexual assault forensic
11	exams to remote tribal communities.
12	"(5) Applicant requirements.—Applicants
13	shall demonstrate coordination with victim service
14	providers, law enforcement (including a crime lab-
15	oratory), and prosecutors.
16	"(6) USE OF FUNDS.—Recipients of a grant
17	under this subsection may use such funds to hire a
18	sexual assault response team.".
