At the end of title IV, add the following:

1 SEC. ____. ACCESS TO PROGRAMS BY TRIBES AND TRIBAL 2 ORGANIZATIONS.

3 (a) STUDY.—The Comptroller General of the United
4 States shall conduct a study on the extent to which Tribes
5 and Tribal organizations can access the programs (and as6 sociated funding) authorized or reauthorized by this Act
7 (including the amendments made by this Act) (in this sec8 tion referred to as "covered programs").

9 (b) CONTENTS.—In conducting the study, the Comp-10 troller General shall—

(1) examine the scope of challenges related to
substance use on Tribal lands and in Tribal communities, including overdoes;

(2) assess barriers to Tribal participation in
covered programs, including the extent to which the
regulations and guidance issued for such programs—

18 (A) address the unique needs of Tribal19 communities; and

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1	(B) allow for tailored interventions related
2	to substance use on Tribal lands;
3	(3) assess the extent to which the Secretary of
4	Health and Human Services, the Attorney General,
5	and the heads of other agencies carrying out covered
6	programs are required—
7	(A) to consult with Tribes on a meaningful
8	basis;
9	(B) to provide technical or other assistance
10	to Tribes to ensure successful implementation
11	of such programs; and
12	(C) to seek Tribal input before issuing
13	guidance with respect to such programs.
14	(c) Report to Congress.—
15	(1) SUBMISSION.—Not later than 3 years after
16	the date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller
17	General shall submit to Congress a report on the re-
18	sults of the study.
19	(2) Recommendations.—The report shall in-
20	clude recommendations of the Comptroller General
21	for improving—
22	(A) access to covered programs by Tribal
23	communities; and
24	(B) the ability of agencies carrying out
25	covered programs to incorporate Tribal input

- 1 into the development of such programs and re-
- 2 lated guidelines.

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
