

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-9**

**OFFERED BY MS. MOORE OF WISCONSIN**

Page 1553, line 21, strike “and” after the semicolon.

Page 1554, line 2, strike the period at the end and insert “; and”.

Page 1554, after line 2, insert the following:

1           “(C) provide, in addition to subparagraph  
2           (B) and to the maximum extent practicable,  
3           that priority for the use of funds be given to  
4           projects that, in carrying out lead service line  
5           replacements, provide job training, apprentice-  
6           ships, or other employment opportunities for  
7           low-income persons and very low-income per-  
8           sons that are located in the area in which the  
9           project is carried out.”.

Page 1555, after line 18, insert the following:

10           “(10) REPORT.—The Administrator shall annu-  
11           ally submit to Congress a report that provides—

1           “(A) the number of households for which  
2           lead service lines have been replaced using  
3           funds made available by this subsection;

4           “(B) the total number of lead service lines  
5           that exist in each State, territory, and area  
6           under the jurisdiction of an Indian Tribe that  
7           has entered into an agreement pursuant to this  
8           subsection;

9           “(C) with respect to each project for such  
10          lead service line replacement, data on job train-  
11          ing, apprenticeships, and other employment op-  
12          portunities for persons described in paragraph  
13          (4)(C) under such projects, which shall include  
14          the amount of the funding used to hire such  
15          persons for such project; and

16          “(D) any other data determined by the Ad-  
17          ministrator to be useful for purposes of deter-  
18          mining the effect of this subsection with respect  
19          to replacing lead service lines.”.

Page 1556, after line 25, insert the following:

20           “(D) LOW-INCOME PERSON; VERY LOW-IN-  
21           COME PERSON.—The terms ‘low-income person’  
22           and ‘very low-income person’ have the same  
23           meanings given the terms ‘low-income families’  
24           and ‘very low-income families’, respectively, in

1 section 3(b) of the United States Housing Act  
2 of 1937 (42 U.S.C.14 1437a(b)).”.

Page 1562, line 23, strike “In making” and insert  
the following:

3 “(A) IN GENERAL.—In making”.

Page 1563, after line 4, insert the following:

4 “(B) OTHER PRIORITIES.—In making  
5 grants under the program established under  
6 this subsection, the Administrator shall, to the  
7 greatest extent feasible, also give priority to  
8 States and local educational agencies that, in  
9 assisting with the installation and maintenance  
10 of filtration stations pursuant to this sub-  
11 section, will provide job training, apprentice-  
12 ships, or other employment opportunities for  
13 low-income persons and very low-income per-  
14 sons in the area in which the installation and  
15 maintenance takes place.”.
