

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 118–10**

**OFFERED BY MS. MOORE OF WISCONSIN**

At the appropriate place in subtitle B of title XVIII,  
insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_ . REPORT ON SENEGAL.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the  
3 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of State,  
4 in consultation with the Secretary of Defense and the  
5 heads of other relevant Federal departments and agencies,  
6 shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees  
7 a report on ongoing efforts to promote democracy and sup-  
8 port the peace and stability in Senegal, including informa-  
9 tion on the following:

10 (1) United States efforts to promote democracy  
11 and the rule of law in the country, including to pro-  
12 tect the right to peacefully protest.

13 (2) United States efforts to protect the ability  
14 of the people of Senegal to determine their own fu-  
15 ture, including to support free and fair 2024 presi-  
16 dential elections and respect for constitutional limits.

17 (3) The United States response to political  
18 prosecutions of political or civil society leaders in  
19 Senegal.

1           (4) United States efforts to address adverse  
2           economic conditions in the country, including unem-  
3           ployment.

4           (5) United States efforts to ensure that—

5                   (A) Senegalese authorities conduct a cred-  
6                   ible, independent, and transparent investigation  
7                   into the circumstances of protestor deaths that  
8                   occurred in June 2023; and

9                   (B) security forces, police, or other individ-  
10                  uals responsible for unlawful killings are held  
11                  accountable in fair trials.

12          (6) A description of United States efforts to en-  
13          sure that security and other cooperation with Sen-  
14          egal does not come at the expense of efforts to pro-  
15          mote democracy, good governance initiatives, respect  
16          for human rights, and a robust and engaged civil so-  
17          ciety.

18          (7) A description of the United States response  
19          to reports that social media and mobile Internet  
20          service were suspended by the Government of Sen-  
21          egal in response to ongoing protests, in direct con-  
22          travention of United States policies supporting an  
23          open, interoperable, reliable, and secure internet  
24          which promotes democracy and human rights such  
25          as freedom of expression and which opposes efforts

1 to bypass internet through blocking, filtering, and  
2 other censorship techniques.

3 (b) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMITTEES  
4 DEFINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate con-  
5 gressional committees” means the Committee on Armed  
6 Services of the House of Representatives, the Committee  
7 on Armed Services of the Senate, the Committee on For-  
8 eign Affairs of the House of Representatives, and the  
9 Committee on Foreign Relations of the Senate.
