Page 385, after line 14, insert the following (and redesignate accordingly):

1 (c) ADDITIONAL AIRPORTS.—No later than 2 years 2 after the establishment of the information sharing mecha-3 nism under subsection (a), the Administrator shall extend 4 that mechanism to other large or medium sized hub air-5 ports outside the Washington, D.C. area that request such a mechanism and where helicopter noise complaints are 6 7 occurring, if the Administrator determines that doing so is appropriate and feasible. If the Administrator deter-8 9 mines doing so is not feasible, the Administrator shall provide to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastruc-10 11 ture of the House of Representatives and the Committee 12 on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate 13 a report outlining reasons why such actions are not fea-14 sible and providing alternatives the Administrator has to 15 work with other airports and concerned community members to address concerns about noise from helicopter oper-16 ations at airports. 17

At the end of title VIII, add the following:

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Federal 6 Aviation Administration shall collaborate with neighbor-7 hood groups, helicopter operators, airport officials, and 8 other interested stakeholders regarding noise concerns 9 about helicopter operations at General Mitchell Inter-10 national Airport in Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

(b) OUTREACH AND EDUCATION.—In carrying out
subsection(a), the Administrator shall provide outreach
and education to the public and elected officials about options, including to consider modifications to flight paths,
to address public noise complaints.

16 (c) POINT OF CONTACT.—At a minimum, the Admin-17 istrator shall require the airport or helicopter operator to 18 establish a public point of contact (name, phone, and 19 email) for members of the public to direct noise complaints 20 about helicopter operations who shall respond to and keep 21 a record of each such complaint.
