OFFERED BY MS. MOORE OF WISCONSIN

At the end of subtitle F of title V, insert the following new section:

1 **SEC. 5___ . REPORT ON ASSISTANCE PROVIDED TO SUP-**
2 **PORT GREEN ALERT SYSTEMS.**

3 (a) STUDY.—Not later than 180 days after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of
5 the United States shall conduct a study on any assistance
6 provided by the Secretary of Defense and the Secretary
7 of Veterans Affairs with respect to green alert systems,
8 including the following:

9 (1) The frequency to which facilities of the De-
10 partment of Defense and the Department of Vet-
11 erans Affairs have reported or assisted in locating a
12 missing member of the Armed Forces or a missing
13 veteran.

14 (2) The extent to which such Secretaries have
15 assisted with the implementation of a green alert
16 system, including whether the Secretaries have, for
17 the purposes of locating a missing member of the

1 Armed Forces or a missing veteran, provided to a
2 State, local government, or Tribe—

3 (A) financial assistance;

4 (B) technical assistance; or

5 (C) educational assistance.

6 (3) The extent to which such Secretaries have
7 provided any services or support to a member of the
8 Armed Forces or a veteran after such member or
9 veteran is located by a green alert system.

10 (4) Any challenges faced by such Secretaries
11 providing such assistance.

12 (5) Any other information that the Comptroller
13 General may determine to be appropriate.

14 (b) REPORT.—Not later than two years after the date
15 of the enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General shall
16 submit to the Committees on Armed Services and the
17 Committees on Veterans Affairs of the House of Rep-
18 resentatives and the Senate a report on the study con-
19 ducted under subsection (a).

20 (c) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.—The Secretary of De-
21 fense and the Secretary of Veterans Affairs shall provide
22 financial and technical assistance to a State, local govern-
23 ment, or Tribe that has established, or plans to establish,
24 a green alert system.

25 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

1 (1) The term “green alert system” means a
2 missing person system of a State, local government,
3 or Tribe that is dedicated to locating missing mem-
4 bers of the Armed Forces or missing veterans.

5 (2) The term “veteran” has the meaning given
6 such term in section 101 of title 38, United States
7 Code.
