(c) Grants for Emerging or Innovative Water

7 test, or improve emerging or innovative water
8 technologies that may assist public water sys9 tems in monitoring and addressing the sub10 stances described in subsection (a)(2); or

11 (B) provide technical assistance to increase 12 adoption of emerging or innovative water tech-13 nologies that may assist water systems in moni-14 toring and addressing the substances described 15 in subsection (a)(2), including adoption by mu-16 nicipal drinking water and wastewater treat-17 ment systems, areas served by private wells, 18 and water supply systems in arid areas that are 19 experiencing, or have recently experienced, pro2

1	longed drought conditions, in a manner that re-
2	duces ratepayer or community costs over time,
3	including the cost of future capital investments.
4	(2) ELIGIBLE ENTITY.—In this subsection, the
5	term "eligible entity" means—
6	(A) a public water system;
7	(B) an institution of higher education;
8	(C) a research institution or foundation;
9	(D) a regional water organization;
10	(E) a nonprofit organization described in
11	section 1442(e)(8) of the Safe Drinking Water
12	Act (42 U.S.C. 300j-1(e)(8)); or
13	(F) an entity representing a regional,
14	multi-State collaboration among entities de-
15	scribed in this paragraph.
16	(3) Authorization of appropriations.—
17	There is authorized to be appropriated to carry out
18	this subsection $$10,000,000$ for each of fiscal years
19	2021 through 2024.
