Page 42, after line 9, add the following (and make such conforming changes as may be necessary):

1 **SEC. 306. STUDY ON HEALTH OUTCOMES OF USE OF E-**
2 **CIGARETTES DURING PREGNANCY.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Health and
4 Human Services shall enter into an agreement with the
5 National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medi-
6 cine under which the National Academies agree to conduct
7 a study on the health outcomes of the use of e-cigarettes
8 during pregnancy. Such study shall—

9 (1) examine any data gaps in existing Federal
10 and State tobacco use surveillance systems (includ-
11 ing the Pregnancy Risk Assessment Monitoring Sys-
12 tem), with respect to the incidence of pregnant
13 women who use e-cigarettes and birth and other
14 health outcomes for such women and their children;

15 (2) analyze and assess any ongoing Federal re-
16 search with respect to that use; and

17 (3) provide recommendations with respect to
18 additional research, programs, and activities the

1 Federal Government and States can undertake to
2 assist pregnant women in ceasing to use e-cigarettes.

3 (b) REPORT.—The agreement entered into under
4 subsection (a) shall include a requirement that the Na-
5 tional Academies, not later than October 1, 2023, submit
6 to the Committees on Appropriations and Energy and
7 Commerce of the House of Representatives and the Com-
8 mittees on Appropriations and Health, Education, Labor
9 and Pensions of the Senate a report on the results of the
10 study conducted pursuant to subsection (a).
