

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5371**  
**OFFERED BY MR. MOSKOWITZ OF FLORIDA**

Insert at the end of division A (before the short title) the following:

1        SEC. 158. (a) In addition to amounts otherwise pro-  
2        vided by section 101 for “House of Representatives—Sala-  
3        ries, Officers and Employees—Members’ Representational  
4        Allowance”, there is appropriated an additional  
5        \$110,250,000, to remain available until expended, of  
6        which \$250,000 shall be provided to the Members’ Rep-  
7        resentational Allowance of each Member of the House of  
8        Representatives (including each Delegate and Resident  
9        Commissioner to the Congress), subject to subsection (c),  
10       to be used exclusively to hire security personnel, equip-  
11       ment, and related support to protect the Member in the  
12       Washington Metropolitan Area and in the congressional  
13       district the Member represents.

14       (b) In addition to amounts otherwise provided by sec-  
15       tion 101 for “Senate—Senators’ Official Personnel and  
16       Office Expense Account”, there is appropriated an addi-  
17       tional \$25,000,000, to remain available until expended, of  
18       which \$250,000 shall be provided to the Official Personnel  
19       and Office Expense Account of each Senator, subject to

1 subsection (c), to be used exclusively to hire security per-  
2 sonnel, equipment, and related support to protect the Sen-  
3 ator in the Washington Metropolitan Area and in the  
4 State the Senator represents.

5 (c) No additional funds shall be appropriated under  
6 this section to the Members' Representational Allowance  
7 or the Senators' Official Personnel and Office Expense Ac-  
8 count of any Member of the House of Representatives or  
9 Senator unless the Sergeant at Arms of the House of Rep-  
10 resentatives or the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper of  
11 the Senate (as the case may be) certifies that a full-time  
12 protective detail is not already provided to the Member  
13 or Senator by the United States Capitol Police or any  
14 other Federal law enforcement agency.

15 (d) If funds provided under this section are used to  
16 employ an individual whose sole duty is to serve as part  
17 of the security detail of a Member of the House of Rep-  
18 resentatives or a Senator, the individual shall not be  
19 counted toward any limitation on the number of employees  
20 that may be employed in the personal office of the Member  
21 or Senator involved.

22 (e) In this section, the term "Washington Metropoli-  
23 tan Area" means the District of Columbia; the cities of  
24 Alexandria, Falls Church and Fairfax, and the counties

- 1 of Arlington and Fairfax, in Virginia; and the counties of
- 2 Montgomery and Prince George's in Maryland.
