- 17 tional \$25,000,000, to remain available until expended, of
- 18 which \$250,000 shall be provided to the Official Personnel
- 19 and Office Expense Account of each Senator, subject to

- 1 subsection (c), to be used exclusively to hire security per-
- 2 sonnel, equipment, and related support to protect the Sen-
- 3 ator in the Washington Metropolitan Area and in the
- 4 State the Senator represents.
- 5 (c) No additional funds shall be appropriated under
- 6 this section to the Members' Representational Allowance
- 7 or the Senators' Official Personnel and Office Expense Ac-
- 8 count of any Member of the House of Representatives or
- 9 Senator unless the Sergeant at Arms of the House of Rep-
- 10 resentatives or the Sergeant at Arms and Doorkeeper of
