Page 267, after line 10, insert the following:

1	SEC STUDY ON U.S. AIRLINE CONSOLIDATION.
2	(a) STUDY.—Not later than 180 days after the date
3	of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General of the
4	United States shall initiate a study of the effects of United
5	States airline consolidation on consumers, airline safety,
6	including workforce-related issues, and airline operations.
7	(b) Contents.—The study required under sub-
8	section (a) shall address—
9	(1) the financial health of the United States
10	airline industry since 2014, including profitability;
11	(2) trends in airline fees, ticketing, cancella-
12	tions, change and bag fees, and other ancillary fees,
13	and other changes to terms of service;
14	(3) changes to airline safety and security meas-
15	ures implemented by airlines;
16	(4) implementation of NextGen technology;
17	(5) effects on passenger traffic and capacity re-
18	straints;
19	(6) the ability for new airlines to emerge and
20	effectively compete in heavily traveled markets;

1	(7) the effects of consolidation at the route, air-
2	port, airline, industry, and shareholder level on
3	terms of service, ancillary fees, network coverage,
4	and profitability; and
5	(8) for each of the determinations above, such
6	review shall include the effects of consolidation at
7	the route, airport, airline, industry, and shareholder
8	level.
9	(e) Report.—Not later than 18 months after the
10	date of enactment of this Act, the Comptroller General
11	shall submit to the Committee on Transportation and In-
12	frastructure of the House of Representatives and the Com-
13	mittee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the
14	Senate a report on the results of the study.
