OFFERED BY MR. MOYLAN OF GUAM

Add at the end of subtitle C of title XXXV the following:

1 **SEC. 35_____ . COMPTROLLER GENERAL STUDY AND RE-**
2 **PORT RELATING TO THE PORT OF GUAM.**

3 (a) **STUDY REQUIRED.**—Not later than March 1,
4 2024, the Comptroller General of the United States shall
5 complete a study that assesses the following:

6 (1) Geographic and logistical factors that affect
7 costs for shipping building materials to Guam.

8 (2) Implications of such factors on military con-
9 struction projects for the Port of Guam.

10 (3) The state of the facilities of the Port of
11 Guam and estimated costs for repairs or improve-
12 ments to such facilities.

13 (4) The feasibility of expanding the such port
14 facilities or the capacity of the Port of Guam.

15 (5) The feasibility of granting a waiver of the
16 requirements of the Build America, Buy America
17 Act (41 U.S.C. 8301 note) for construction of facili-
18 ties for the Port of Guam.

1 (6) The feasibility of expanding or renewing the
2 Port of Guam Improvement Enterprise Program (es-
3 tablished under section 3512 of the Duncan Hunter
4 National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year
5 2009 (48 U.S.C. 1421r)) to expand uses of funds
6 other than for intermodal or marine facilities

7 (b) REPORT REQUIRED.—Not later than March 1,
8 2024, the Comptroller General of the United States shall
9 submit to the Committee of Armed Services of the House
10 of Representatives and the Senate a report on the results
11 of the study required under subsection (a), including pol-
12 icy recommendations to expedite modernization projects of
13 the Port of Guam.
