AMENDMENT TO

Rules Committee Print 118–10 Offered by Mr. Moylan of Guam

At the end of subtitle B of title XXVIII, add the following:

1 SEC. 28_____. INDEPENDENT ASSESSMENT OF HOUSING FOR 2 PERSONS ENGAGED IN NATIONAL DEFENSE 3 IN GUAM.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense shall 5 seek to enter into an agreement with a federally funded 6 research and development center for an independent as-7 sessment of housing of persons engaged in national de-8 fense in Guam.

9 (b) ELEMENTS.—An assessment under subsection (a)10 shall include the following:

(1) A survey of the housing needs for current
and future military personnel in Guam, accommodating the varying needs of single and married members of the Armed Forces at various stages of their
careers.

16 (2) A survey of housing needs for current and
17 future Department of Defense civilian employees in
18 Guam.

(3) A survey of housing needs for current and
 future workers and workers with families in Guam,
 who are engaged or to be engaged in industries con nected with and essential to national defense
 projects and programs.

6 (4) Possible options for the Secretary to build
7 new housing to accommodate future persons engaged
8 in national defense in Guam and resolve existing
9 housing shortages.

10 (5) Possible strategies for the Secretary to miti11 gate the impact of civilian and military personnel on
12 the local housing supply in Guam.

(c) REPORT.—An entity that enters into an agreement to conduct the assessment described in subsection
(a) shall submit to the Secretary and the Committees on
Armed Services of the Senate and House of Representatives a report containing the findings of the assessment
not later than December 31, 2024.
