At the end of the bill, add the following:

Exception for transportation of LNG be-8 9 tween non-contiguous ports and other 10 ports in the United States 11 "(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a vessel may transport liquified natural gas 12 13 between a port in a non-contiguous area and another port in the United States or a non-contiguous area. 14 15 "(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section: "(1) LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS.—The term 16 17 'liquified natural gas' means liquified natural gas. "(2) NATURAL GAS.—The term 'natural gas' 18 19 has the meaning given such term in section 2 of the

20 Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. 717a).

"(3) NON-CONTIGUOUS AREA.—The term 'non-1 2 contiguous area' means any part of the United 3 States not physically connected to the contiguous 4 United States, including Alaska and Hawaii, and any territory or possession of the United States.". 5 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap-6 ter 551 of title 46, United States Code, is amended by 7 adding at the end the following: 8 "55124. Exception for transportation of LNG between non-contiguous ports and

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other ports in the United States."".
