

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 1130, AS REPORTED  
OFFERED BY MR. MOYLAN OF GUAM**

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. 3. EXCEPTION FOR TRANSPORTATION OF CRUDE OIL,**  
2 **PETROLEUM, PETROLEUM PRODUCTS, AND**  
3 **LIQUIFIED NATURAL GAS BETWEEN HAWAII**  
4 **AND OTHER PORTS IN THE UNITED STATES.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 551 of title 46, United  
6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
7 lowing:

8 **“§ 55124. Exception for transportation of LNG be-**  
9 **tween non-contiguous ports and other**  
10 **ports in the United States**

11 “(a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other pro-  
12 vision of law, a vessel may transport liquified natural gas  
13 between a port in a non-contiguous area and another port  
14 in the United States or a non-contiguous area.

15 “(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

16 “(1) LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS.—The term  
17 ‘liquified natural gas’ means liquified natural gas.

18 “(2) NATURAL GAS.—The term ‘natural gas’  
19 has the meaning given such term in section 2 of the  
20 Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. 717a).

1           “(3) NON-CONTIGUOUS AREA.—The term ‘non-  
2           contiguous area’ means any part of the United  
3           States not physically connected to the contiguous  
4           United States, including Alaska and Hawaii, and  
5           any territory or possession of the United States.”.

6           (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The analysis for chap-  
7           ter 551 of title 46, United States Code, is amended by  
8           adding at the end the following:

          “55124. Exception for transportation of LNG between non-contiguous ports and  
          other ports in the United States.’”.
