13	which assistance from the Bank is first sought after
14	the effective date of this paragraph, unless there is
15	in effect a certification by the Secretary of State
16	that the country has taken sufficient measures to
17	ensure the rights of individuals in the country who
18	are members of a minority group characterized by

the religious practices or ethnicity of its members,
the rights of individuals in the country who are dis abled, the freedom of the media, and the rights of
individuals in the country who are political dis sidents.".
