Page 1032, after line 4, insert the following:

1 **SEC. ____ . PROHIBITION ON SUPPORT FOR EXPORT TO**
2 **COUNTRY THAT HAS NOT TAKEN SUFFICIENT**
3 **MEASURES TO ENSURE HUMAN RIGHTS.**

4 Section 2(b) of the Export-Import Bank Act of 1945
5 (12 U.S.C. 635(b)) is amended by adding at the end the
6 following:

7 “(14) PROHIBITION ON SUPPORT FOR EXPORT
8 TO COUNTRY THAT HAS NOT TAKEN SUFFICIENT
9 MEASURES TO ENSURE HUMAN RIGHTS.—The Bank
10 may not guarantee, insure, or extend (participate in
11 the extension of) credit in connection with the export
12 of a good or service to a country, with respect to
13 which assistance from the Bank is first sought after
14 the effective date of this paragraph, unless there is
15 in effect a certification by the Secretary of State
16 that the country has taken sufficient measures to
17 ensure the rights of individuals in the country who
18 are members of a minority group characterized by

1 the religious practices or ethnicity of its members,
2 the rights of individuals in the country who are dis-
3 abled, the freedom of the media, and the rights of
4 individuals in the country who are political dis-
5 sidents.”.
