

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 3180, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MRS. MURPHY OF FLORIDA**

Add at the end of title V the following new section:

1 **SEC. 504. NORTH KOREA MONITORING AND ENFORCEMENT.**

2 (a) ESTABLISHMENT.—Not later than 90 days after  
3 the date of the enactment of this Act, the Director of Na-  
4 tional Intelligence shall establish an integration cell (in  
5 this section referred to as the “Integration Cell”) among  
6 relevant elements of the intelligence community to inte-  
7 grate intelligence relating to the monitoring and enforce-  
8 ment of United Nations Security Council resolutions with  
9 respect to North Korea.

10 (b) DUTIES.—The Integration Cell shall—

11 (1) coordinate and synchronize all intelligence  
12 collection relating to the implementation of sanctions  
13 against North Korea;

14 (2) integrate the early warning systems of the  
15 intelligence community with respect to detecting ac-  
16 tivities by North Korea to proliferate weapons of  
17 mass destruction;

18 (3) identify any gaps in intelligence relating to  
19 the monitoring of the nuclear weapons program of  
20 North Korea; and

1           (4) provide net assessments and recommenda-  
2           tions to the Director of National Intelligence relating  
3           to North Korea.

4           (c) STRUCTURE.—

5           (1) HEAD.—The Integration Cell shall be head-  
6           ed by a member of the Senior Intelligence Service,  
7           who shall report to the Director of National Intel-  
8           ligence.

9           (2) STAFFING.—The Integration Cell may be  
10          staffed by detailing or assigning to the Integration  
11          Cell personnel of an element of the intelligence com-  
12          munity, or core contractor personnel of such an ele-  
13          ment, who would otherwise conduct such work as  
14          part of their normal responsibilities at such element.

15          (d) REPORTS.—Not later than 180 days after the  
16          date of the enactment of this Act, and annually thereafter,  
17          the Director of National Intelligence shall submit to Con-  
18          gress a report that includes the following:

19               (1) A detailed description of the activities of the  
20               Integration Cell.

21               (2) Recommendations for the better collection  
22               of intelligence on activities by North Korea to pro-  
23               liferate weapons of mass destruction.

24          (e) INTELLIGENCE COMMUNITY DEFINED.—In this  
25          section, the term “intelligence community” has the mean-

1 ing given that term in section 3(4) of the National Secu-  
2 rity Act of 1947 (50 U.S.C. 3003(4)).
