

Sec. ___ Update of Intelligence Community-Coordinated Report on Global Water Security

- (a) UPDATE REQUIRED.—Not later than April 1, 2027, the Director of National Intelligence, in coordination with the Secretary of Defense and the heads of appropriate elements of the intelligence community, shall submit to the appropriate committees an updated version of the report entitled “Global Water Security, Intelligence Community Assessment, ICA 2012-08.”
- (b) CONTENTS.—The updated report required under subsection (a) shall include—
 - (1) All elements in the original report with updated data and analysis;
 - (2) Relevant developments since the submission of the original report;
 - (3) An analysis of the efforts of foreign adversarial governments’ efforts to gain access to, exert control over, or manipulate water resources, including their rate of acquisition of or control over groundwater or surface water beyond their sovereign territory, including transboundary waters, and geographical reach;
 - (4) An assessment of trends related to conflict over water or attacks on water; and
 - (5) Any additional matters the Director determines appropriate or that the congressional intelligence committees may specify.
- (c) FORM.—The report required under this section shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include a classified annex.
- (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section, the term “appropriate congressional committees” means—
 - a. The House and Senate Committees on Armed Services;
 - b. The House Committee on Foreign Affairs;
 - c. The Senate Committee on Foreign Relations;
 - d. The House and Senate Committees on Intelligence;
 - e. The House and Senate Committees on Appropriations;
