Amendment to the Rules Committee Print for H.R. 1735 Offered by Ms. Moore of Wisconsin

At the end of title IV (page 83, after line 16), add the following new section:

1	SEC. 422. SENSE OF CONGRESS ON THE PRESERVATION OF
2	END STRENGTH LEVELS FOR THE ARMY AND
3	ITS RESERVE COMPONENTS.
4	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:
5	(1) Congress created the National Commission
6	on the Future of the Army (in this section referred
7	to as the "Commission") to undertake a comprehen-
8	sive study of the structure of the Army and policy
9	assumptions related to the size and force mixture of
10	the Army, and charged it with providing rec-
11	ommendations on the proper size and force mixture
12	of the Army and its reserve components.
13	(2) The Commission is mandated to issue its
14	final report in February 2016, yet the fiscal year
15	2016 budget proposal called for serious cuts to
16	Army manpower including a reduction of 15,000 in
17	the Active duty force and 8,200 in the Army Na-
18	tional Guard.

(b) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—In light of the findings
 in subsection (a), it is the sense of Congress that—

3 (1) it would be unwise to make changes that
4 will permanently affect the structure of the military
5 prior to receiving and considering the analysis, eval6 uation, and recommendations of the Commission;
7 and

8 (2) the Secretary of the Army should not im-9 pose any further reductions in end strengths until 10 the Secretary receives the report of the National 11 Commission on the Future of the Army pursuant to 12 section 1703(c) of the National Commission on the 13 Future of the Army Act of 2014 (subtitle A of title 14 XVII of Public Law 113–291).
