

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMM. PRINT 119-8
OFFERED BY MR. NADLER OF NEW YORK

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following:

1 **SEC. 17 ____ . REPORT.**

2 (a) Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-
3 ment of this Act, the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff
4 and the Secretary of Defense, in coordination with Sec-
5 retary of State and the Director of National Intelligence,
6 shall submit to the appropriate congressional committees
7 a report, in unclassified form but which may contain a
8 classified annex if necessary, that includes the following:

9 (1) A detailed battle damage assessment (BDA)
10 of the United States strike on Iranian nuclear facili-
11 ties on and around June 21, 2025, including—

12 (A) the impact on the Iranian nuclear pro-
13 gram;

14 (B) the specific remaining capabilities of
15 the sites targeted after the strike;

16 (C) any resulting difference in breakout
17 time of the Iranian nuclear program;

18 (D) an assessment of any remaining nu-
19 clear material; and

1 (E) an assessment of the impact of the
2 United States strike on the Iranian ballistic
3 missile program and proxy activity.

4 (2) An assessment of whether the United States
5 withdrawal from the Joint Comprehensive Plan of
6 Action (JCPOA) accelerated or slowed Iran's break-
7 out timeline, and the likelihood that not withdrawing
8 from the agreement would have led to the conditions
9 that were deemed as justification for the United
10 States strike.

11 (3) An assessment of the impact of Iran's sus-
12 pension of International Atomic Energy Agency
13 (IAEA) cooperation and the withdrawal of IAEA in-
14 spectors from Iran, and what led to Iran's taking
15 such action.

16 (b) In this section, the term "appropriate congres-
17 sional committees" means—

18 (1) the Committee on Appropriations, the Com-
19 mittee on Armed Services, and the Committee on
20 Foreign Affairs of the House of Representatives;
21 and

22 (2) the Committee on Appropriations, the Com-
23 mittee on Armed Services, and the Committee on
24 Foreign Relations of the Senate.
