(b) REPORT.—Not later than one year after the date

shall report to Congress on the considerations under subsection (a).

17 (c) INNOVATIVE HOUSING PRODUCTION COMPANY18 DEFINED.—In this section, the term "innovative housing

production company" means a company that offers hous ing in an area for which the costs per unit is lower than
 the cost per unit of other housing in the area that meets
 Federal, State, and local housing standards, based on
 quality, accessibility, and durability.
