

Proposed Amendment Text:

SEC. ____. ASSESSMENT OF DEPARTMENT OF WAR DISPLAY SUPPLY CHAIN VULNERABILITIES.

(a) ASSESSMENT REQUIRED.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of War, in coordination with the Secretary of Commerce, shall conduct an assessment of supply chain vulnerabilities related to displays used in Department of War weapon systems and platforms.

(b) ELEMENTS.—The assessment shall include—

- (1) identification of defense systems dependent on displays sourced from the People's Republic of China or Taiwan;
- (2) assessment of supply disruption risks and potential operational impacts;
- (3) evaluation of domestic or allied manufacturing capabilities for advanced display technologies;
- (4) analysis of emerging display technologies, including MicroLED Displays, and
- (5) recommendations for reducing foreign dependence in critical display applications.

(c) FORM.—The assessment shall be submitted in unclassified form, but may include a classified annex.
