

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 115-  
70  
OFFERED BY MS. ADAMS OF NORTH CAROLINA**

At the end of subtitle G of title X of the bill, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 10\_\_ . PROMOTING FEDERAL PROCUREMENT WITH**  
2 **HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGES AND UNI-**  
3 **VERSITIES AND MINORITY INSTITUTIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—The head of an executive agency,  
5 or a contracting officer where applicable, shall—

6 (1) assist historically Black colleges and univer-  
7 sities and minority institutions to develop viable,  
8 self-sustaining businesses capable of competing on  
9 an equal basis in the mainstream of the United  
10 States economy; and

11 (2) promote Federal procurement with histori-  
12 cally Black colleges and universities and minority in-  
13 stitutions by establishing—

14 (A) participation goals of not less than 10  
15 percent for historically Black colleges and uni-  
16 versities and minority institutions;

17 (B) requirements that prime contractors  
18 and other recipients of Federal funds attain

1 similar participation goals in their procurement;  
2 and

3 (C) other mechanisms that ensure histori-  
4 cally Black colleges and universities and minor-  
5 ity institutions have a fair opportunity to par-  
6 ticipate in Federal procurement.

7 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

8 (1) The term “executive agency” has the mean-  
9 ing given the term in section 133 of title 41, United  
10 States Code.

11 (2) The term “historically Black college and  
12 university” has the meaning given that term in sec-  
13 tion 631 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20  
14 U.S.C. 1132).

15 (3) The term “minority institution” has the  
16 meaning given that term in section 365 of the High-  
17 er Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1067k).
