

**AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 117-**

**OFFERED BY MS. WILLIAMS OF GEORGIA**

At the end of subtitle G of title X, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 10\_\_ . PUBLIC AVAILABILITY OF COST OF CERTAIN**  
2 **MILITARY OPERATIONS TO EACH UNITED**  
3 **STATES TAXPAYER.**

4 Section 1090 of the National Defense Authorization  
5 Act for Fiscal Year 2017 (Public Law 114–328) is amend-  
6 ed—

7 (1) by inserting “(a) PUBLICATION OF INFOR-  
8 MATION.—” before “The Secretary of Defense”;

9 (2) by striking “of each of the wars in Afghani-  
10 stan, Iraq, and Syria.” and inserting “of any over-  
11 seas contingency operation conducted by the United  
12 States Armed Forces on or after September 18,  
13 2001.”; and

14 (3) by adding at the end the following new sub-  
15 sections:

16 “(b) DISPLAY OF INFORMATION.—The information  
17 required to be posted under subsection (a) shall—

1           “(1) be posted directly on the website of the  
2           Department of Defense, in an accessible and clear  
3           format;

4           “(2) include corresponding documentation as  
5           links or attachments; and

6           “(3) include, for each overseas contingency op-  
7           eration—

8                   “(A) both the total cost to each taxpayer,  
9                   and the cost to each taxpayer for each fiscal  
10                  year, of conducting the overseas contingency op-  
11                  eration;

12                   “(B) a list of countries where the overseas  
13                  contingency operation has taken place.

14           “(c) UPDATES.—The Secretary shall ensure that all  
15           the information required to be posted under subsection (a)  
16           is updated by not later than 90 days after the last day  
17           of each fiscal year.

18           “(d) CONTINGENCY OPERATION DEFINED.—In this  
19           section, the term ‘contingency operation’ has the meaning  
20           given such term in section 101(a)(13) of title 10, United  
21           States Code.”.
