14	(2) Scope of code.—The code of practices de-

the Maritime and Coastguard Agency of the United

3 (3) DEADLINE.—The Secretary shall complete
4 the development of the code required by this section
5 by not later than one year after the date of the en6 actment of this Act.

7 (b) CONSTRUCTION OF COMPLIANCE WITH CODE 8 FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.—Any vessel determined by the 9 Secretary of the department in which the Coast Guard is 10 operating to be in compliance with the code under this 11 section shall not be subject to inspection under part B of 12 subtitle II of title 46, United States Code, notwithstanding 13 section 3301(7) of such title.

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
