

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 27
OFFERED BY MR. NEGUSE OF COLORADO

At the end of the bill, add the following:

1 **SEC. ____.** **PROJECT SAFE NEIGHBORHOODS GRANT PRO-**
2 **GRAM.**

3 (a) REAUTHORIZATION.—

4 (1) DEFINITIONS.—Section 2 of the Project
5 Safe Neighborhoods Grant Program Authorization
6 Act of 2018 (34 U.S.C. 60701) is amended—

7 (A) by redesignating paragraphs (1), (2),
8 and (3) as paragraphs (2), (4), and (5), respec-
9 tively;

10 (B) by inserting before paragraph (2), as
11 so redesignated, the following:

12 “(1) the term ‘crime analyst’ means an indi-
13 vidual employed by a law enforcement agency for the
14 purpose of separating information into key compo-
15 nents and contributing to plans of action to under-
16 stand, mitigate, and neutralize criminal threats;”;
17 and

18 (C) by inserting after paragraph (2), as so
19 redesignated, the following:

1 “(3) the term ‘law enforcement assistant’
2 means an individual employed by a law enforcement
3 agency or a prosecuting agency for the purpose of
4 aiding law enforcement officers in investigative or
5 administrative duties;”.

6 (2) USE OF FUNDS.—Section 4(b) of the
7 Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant Program Author-
8 ization Act of 2018 (34 U.S.C. 60703(b)) is amend-
9 ed—

10 (A) in paragraph (3), by striking “or” at
11 the end;

12 (B) in paragraph (4), by striking the pe-
13 riod at the end and inserting a semicolon; and

14 (C) by adding at the end the following:

15 “(5) hiring crime analysts to assist with violent
16 crime reduction efforts;

17 “(6) the cost of overtime for law enforcement
18 officers, prosecutors, and law enforcement assistants
19 that assist with the Program; and

20 “(7) purchasing, implementing, and using tech-
21 nology to assist with violent crime reduction ef-
22 forts.”.

23 (3) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—
24 Section 6 of the Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant
25 Program Authorization Act of 2018 (34 U.S.C.

1 60705) is amended by striking “fiscal years 2019
2 through 2021” and inserting “fiscal years 2026
3 through 2030”.

4 (b) TASK FORCE SUPPORT.—Section 4(b) of the
5 Project Safe Neighborhoods Grant Program Authorization
6 Act of 2018 (34 U.S.C. 60703(b)), as amended by section
7 3(b), is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (6), by striking “and” at the
9 end;

10 (2) in paragraph (7), by striking the period at
11 the end and inserting “; and”; and

12 (3) by adding at the end the following:

13 “(8) support for multi-jurisdictional task
14 forces.”.

15 (c) TRANSPARENCY.—Not less frequently than annu-
16 ally, the Attorney General shall submit to the Committee
17 on the Judiciary of the Senate and the Committee on the
18 Judiciary of the House of Representatives a report that
19 details, for each area in which the Project Safe Neighbor-
20 hoods Block Grant Program operates and with respect to
21 the 1-year period preceding the date of the report—

22 (1) how the area spent funds under the Project
23 Safe Neighborhoods Block Grant Program;

24 (2) the community outreach efforts performed
25 in the area; and

1 (3) the number and a description of the violent
2 crime offenses committed in the area, including mur-
3 der, non-negligent manslaughter, rape, robbery, and
4 aggravated assault.
