At the end of subtitle B of title V, add the following:

1	SEC EXCEPTION TO LIMITATIONS ON PERSONNEL.
2	For fiscal year 2022 and fiscal years thereafter, the
3	baseline personnel limitations in sections 143, 194, 7014,
4	8014, and 9014 of title 10, United States Code shall not
5	apply to personnel deemed by the Secretary of Defense
6	or the Secretary of the Military Department concerned as
7	necessary to accommodate increases in workload or modify
8	the type of personnel required to accomplish work to de-
9	velop, administer, or oversee plans, programs or activities
10	related to one or more of the following:
11	(1) Maintaining or enhancing military installa-
12	tion resilience, as defined in section 101(e)(8) of this
13	title.
14	(2) Addressing the vulnerabilities of the defense
15	industrial base and related supply chains to the im-
16	pacts of extreme weather events, or from anticipated
17	or unanticipated changes in environmental condi-
18	tions.

1	(3) Monitoring, addressing, and remedying per-
2	and polyfluoroalkyl (PFAS) contamination that im-
3	pacts military installations and operations.
4	(4) Enhancing the water and energy resilience
5	and assurance of military installations within the
6	United States and abroad.
7	(5) Reducing the net greenhouse gas emissions
8	of the Department of Defense in ways that protect
9	and enhance the operational capacity of the Depart-
10	ment of Defense.
11	(6) Ensuring the full and timely implementa-
12	tion of and compliance with requirements enacted by
13	Congress related to one or more of the matters in
14	paragraphs (1) through (5).
