AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-10

OFFERED BY MR. NEGUSE OF COLORADO

At the end of subtitle G of title V, add the following new section:

1 SEC. 5____. MILITARY VEHICLE OPERATOR TRAINING PRO 2 GRAM.

3 (a) ESTABLISHMENT OF TRAINING CURRICULUM.—
4 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days

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5 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Sec6 retary of Defense shall establish a standardized
7 training curriculum for military vehicle operations,
8 encompassing both classroom and practical training
9 components.

10 (2) DEVELOPMENT.—The training curriculum 11 under paragraph (1) shall be developed in collabora-12 tion with subject matter experts, experienced mem-13 bers of the Armed Forces, and relevant stakeholders, 14 and shall cover essential topics such as vehicle dy-15 namics, safety procedures, hazard recognition and 16 avoidance, defensive driving techniques, and vehicle 17 recovery methods.

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(3) UPDATES.—The Secretary of Defense shall
 ensure that the training curriculum under paragraph
 (1) is regularly updated to incorporate emerging
 best practices and technological advancements in
 military vehicle operations.

6 (b) CERTIFICATION PROGRAM.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Defense
8 shall establish a certification program to validate the
9 proficiency of members of the Armed Forces in mili10 tary vehicle operations.

(2) DESIGN OF PROGRAM.—The certification
program shall be designed to ensure that all members of the Armed Forces, regardless of deployment
status, receive adequate training in military vehicle
operations before being assigned to operational duty.

16 (3) ASSESSMENTS.—The certification program
17 shall include written exams, practical assessments,
18 and evaluations of demonstrated competence.

(4) NOTICE OF COMPLETION.—Notice shall be
issued to members of the Armed Forces who successfully complete the training program and meet
the established proficiency criteria.

23 (c) DEADLINES.—

24 (1) DEADLINE FOR COMMENCEMENT.—Not
25 later than one year after the date of the enactment

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of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall commence
 the development and implementation of the training
 curriculum under subsection (a) and the certification
 program under subsection (b).

5 (2) DEADLINE FOR FULL INTEGRATION.—Not 6 later than three years after the date of the enact-7 ment of this Act, the training curriculum under sub-8 section (a) and the certification program under sub-9 section (b) shall be fully integrated into military 10 training programs.

11 (d) TRAINING DELIVERY METHODS.—In carrying12 out this section, the Secretary of Defense shall—

(1) develop a comprehensive and interactive
training methodology that combines traditional
classroom instruction with hands-on, practical training exercises:

17 (2) encourage the use of modern training tech18 nologies, simulators, and realistic training environ19 ments to enhance effectiveness of the training pro20 gram; and

(3) ensure that training materials are up-todate, accessible, and tailored to the specific vehicle
types and operational environments members of the
Armed Forces are likely to encounter.

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(e) INFORMATION COLLECTION AND EVALUA TIONS.—In carrying out this section, the Secretary of De fense shall—

4 (1) update reporting mechanisms used to collect
5 and analyze data related to military vehicle inci6 dents, including vehicle rollovers, and the causes of
7 such incidents;

8 (2) conduct regular evaluations of the effective-9 ness of the training under this section in reducing 10 incidents and improving the proficiency of military 11 vehicle operators; and

(3) promptly implement any recommendations
for program improvements based on the results of
such data and evaluations.

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
