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1 "(b) COMMUNITY INPUT.—In implementing reason-2 able accommodations under subsection (a), an owner or operator of a general aviation airport and the Adminis-3 4 trator shall take into account input received from individ-5 uals or entities in communities surrounding the airport. 6 "(c) FEDERAL FUNDING.—No Federal funds, includ-7 ing a grant under this chapter, may be withheld from, 8 withdrawn from, or denied to a general aviation airport 9 based solely on an activity carried out by an owner or op-10 erator of such airport under this section.

11 "(d) EMERGENCIES.—The Administrator may reject
12 or temporarily restrict an accommodation under sub13 section (a), as necessary, in the case of an emergency.

14 "(e) DEFINITION OF GENERAL AVIATION AIR15 PORT.—In this section, the term 'general aviation airport'
16 meas a noncertified airport covered by part 139 of title
17 14, Code of Federal Regulations.".

(b) ANALYSIS.—The analysis for subchapter II of
chapter 475 of title 49, United States Code, is amended
by adding at the end the following:

"47535. Authority of general aviation airports to restrict flights for purposes of implementing aircraft noise limitations.".

(c) REGULATORY UPDATES.—The Secretary of
Transportation shall issue such regulations as are necessary to update part 150 and part 161 of title 14, Code
of Federal Regulations, to allow the owners and operators

1 of general aviation airports to implement effective noise

2 abatement measures, as determined appropriate by such

3 owners and operators.

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
