1 SEC. 1150. REVIEW OF FAA AND NASA COLLABORATION ON 2 AVIATION RESEARCH AND TECHNOLOGY. 3 (a) GAO REVIEW OF FAA AND NASA COLLABORA-TION.—The Comptroller General of the United States 4 5 shall conduct a comprehensive review of collaboration be-6 tween the FAA and NASA on advanced aviation research 7 and technologies. The review shall identify the following: 8 collaborative (1)Existing programs and 9 projects. 10 (2) Mechanisms of collaboration. 11 (3) Sharing of facilities. 12 (4) The degree to which FAA and NASA facili-13 tate partnerships between subject matter experts to 14 support the research and development, testing, and 15 certification of advanced aviation technologies. 16 (5) The extent to which the collaborative pro-17 grams and projects include partnerships with other 18 Federal agencies, industry, and research organiza-19 tions.

(6) Other aspects of FAA and NASA collabora tion on aviation research and technology the Comp troller General determines necessary be included in
the review.

5 (7) Ways to improve collaboration, other areas 6 that may benefit from collaboration, and means for 7 improving the efficiency of aeronautics research and 8 development programs to reduce overlap between 9 NASA and the FAA, and with other Federal agen-10 cies and other partners.

11 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 30 days after com-12 pleting the review under subsection (a), the Comptroller 13 General of the United States shall submit to the appro-14 priate committees of Congress a report containing the re-15 sults of the review, along with recommendations for such 16 future action as the Comptroller General determines ap-17 propriate.
