**OFFERED BY MR. NEGUSE OF COLORADO**

Page 1455, after line 25, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 5502. AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH COMMEMORA-**  
2 **TIVE WORK.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Every Word We Utter Monu-  
4 ment may establish a commemorative work on Federal  
5 land in the District of Columbia and its environs to com-  
6 memorate the women’s suffrage movement and the pas-  
7 sage of the 19th Amendment to the Constitution, which  
8 gave women the right to vote.

9 (b) COMPLIANCE WITH STANDARDS FOR COMMEMO-  
10 RATIVE WORKS.—The establishment of the commemora-  
11 tive work under this section shall be in accordance with  
12 chapter 89 of title 40, United States Code (commonly  
13 known as the “Commemorative Works Act”).

14 (c) PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FEDERAL  
15 FUNDS.—

16 (1) IN GENERAL.—Federal funds may not be  
17 used to pay any expense of the establishment of the  
18 commemorative work under this section.

1           (2) RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EVERY WORD WE  
2           UTTER MONUMENT.—The Every Word We Utter  
3           Monument shall be solely responsible for acceptance  
4           of contributions for, and payment of the expenses of,  
5           the establishment of the commemorative work under  
6           this section.

7           (d) DEPOSIT OF EXCESS FUNDS.—

8           (1) IN GENERAL.—If upon payment of all ex-  
9           penses for the establishment of the memorial (in-  
10          cluding the maintenance and preservation amount  
11          required by section 8906(b)(1) of title 40, United  
12          States Code), there remains a balance of funds re-  
13          ceived for the establishment of the commemorative  
14          work, the Every Word We Utter Monument shall  
15          transmit the amount of the balance to the Secretary  
16          of the Interior for deposit in the account provided  
17          for in section 8906(b)(3) of title 40, United States  
18          Code.

19          (2) ON EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY.—If upon  
20          expiration of the authority for the commemorative  
21          work under section 8903(e) of title 40, United  
22          States Code, there remains a balance of funds re-  
23          ceived for the establishment of the commemorative  
24          work, the Every Word We Utter Monument shall  
25          transmit the amount of the balance to a separate ac-

1 count with the National Park Foundation for memo-  
2 rials, to be available to the Secretary of the Interior  
3 or Administrator (as appropriate) following the proc-  
4 ess provided in section 8906(b)(4) of title 40, United  
5 States Code, for accounts established under  
6 8906(b)(2) or (3) of title 40, United States Code.
