

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 119-8**OFFERED BY MR. NEGUSE OF COLORADO**

At the end of subtitle A of title XVI add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 16 ____ . ASSISTANCE BY UNITED STATES SPACE COM-**
2 **MAND TO TRACK FENTANYL TRAFFICKING.**

3 (a) AUTHORITY.—Chapter 135 of title 10, United
4 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing new section:

6 **“§ 2279e. Provision of assistance to track fentanyl**
7 **trafficking**

8 “(a) AUTHORITY.—The Secretary of Defense and the
9 Commander of the United States Space Command shall
10 use the technology and resources of the United States
11 Space Command to provide assistance to covered depart-
12 ments and agencies with respect to tracking fentanyl traf-
13 ficking, including precursor chemicals and supplies and
14 the entities carrying out such trafficking.

15 “(b) COVERED DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES.—In
16 this section, the term ‘covered departments and agencies’
17 means the following:

18 “(1) The Department of Justice.

19 “(2) The Federal Bureau of Investigation.

1 “(3) The Drug Enforcement Administration.

2 “(4) The Office of Homeland Security Inves-
3 tigation of the Department of Homeland Security.

4 “(5) Any other department or agency of the
5 Federal Government, including elements of the intel-
6 ligence community, the Secretary determines appro-
7 priate.”.

8 (b) REPORT.—Not later than five years after the date
9 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
10 shall submit to Congress a report on assistance provided
11 under section 2279e of title 10, United States Code, as
12 added by subsection (a), including an assessment of—

13 (1) the effectiveness of the technology used to
14 provide such assistance; and

15 (2) how such assistance has affected fentanyl
16 trafficking investigations.
