8 (1) UPDATE TRAINING PROGRAMS.—Not later 9 than 180 days after the date of the enactment of 10 this Act, the Secretary of Veterans Affairs (in this section referred to as the "Secretary") shall, acting 11 12 through the Under Secretary for Benefits (in this section referred to as the "Under Secretary"), up-13 14 date an ongoing, national training program for 15 claims processors who review claims for compensa-16 tion for service-connected post-traumatic stress dis-17 order.
