

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 8038

OFFERED BY MR. NEGUSE OF COLORADO

Add, at the end of the bill, the following:

1 **DIVISION Q—COMBATING ON-**
2 **LINE FENTANYL TRAF-**
3 **FICKING**

4 **SEC. 1. SHORT TITLE.**

5 This Act may be cited as the “Combating Online
6 Fentanyl Trafficking Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. INCENTIVE PAY AUTHORITIES FOR POSITIONS RE-**
8 **QUIRING SPECIALIZED SKILLS TO COMBAT**
9 **FENTANYL TRAFFICKING.**

10 (a) **DEFINITION.**—In this Act, the term “cyber
11 skills” means expertise in computers, computer networks,
12 information technology, or the internet.

13 (b) **INCENTIVE PAY.**—Subject to the availability of
14 appropriations, and in accordance with the comparable
15 level of the General Schedule, the Attorney General shall
16 provide incentive pay, in an amount that is not more than
17 25 percent of the basic pay of the individual, to any indi-
18 vidual appointed to a position in the Department of Jus-
19 tice that requires significant cyber skills to aid in the de-
20 tection, prevention, or prosecution of fentanyl trafficking.

1 (c) LIMITATIONS.—Any incentive pay received under
2 subsection (b) by an individual in a position in the Depart-
3 ment of Justice—

4 (1) shall be disregarded in calculating the ag-
5 gregate of the basic pay and premium pay paid to
6 the individual for purposes of the pay period limita-
7 tion and the annual limitation under section 5547 of
8 title 5, United States Code; and

9 (2) shall be treated as part of basic pay for
10 purposes of section 8331(3) of title 5, United States
11 Code.
