

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT

OFFERED BY MR. NEGUSE OF COLORADO

At the end of subtitle B of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 **SEC. 17___ . REAUTHORIZATION OF MOSQUITO ABATEMENT**
2 **FOR SAFETY AND HEALTH PROGRAM.**

3 Section 317S of the Public Health Service Act (42
4 U.S.C. 247b–21) is amended—

5 (1) in subsection (a)(3)(A), by striking “sub-
6 section (b)(3)” and inserting “subsection (b)(4)”;

7 (2) in subsection (b)—

8 (A) by redesignating paragraphs (3)
9 through (6) as paragraphs (4) through (7), re-
10 spectively; and

11 (B) by inserting after paragraph (2) the
12 following:

13 “(3) CONSIDERATIONS.—The Secretary may
14 consider the use of innovative and novel technology
15 for mosquito prevention and control in making
16 grants under paragraph (1).”;

17 (3) by amending subsection (d) to read as fol-
18 lows:

1 “(d) USES OF FUNDS.—

2 “(1) TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE.—Amounts ap-
3 propriated under subsection (f) may be used by the
4 Secretary to provide training and technical assist-
5 ance with respect to the planning, development, and
6 operation of assessments and plans under subsection
7 (a) and control programs under subsection (b). The
8 Secretary may provide such training and technical
9 assistance directly or through awards of grants or
10 contracts to public and private entities.

11 “(2) EDUCATION.—A recipient of an award
12 under subsection (a) or (b) may use up to 5 percent
13 of the total amount provided for each fiscal year to
14 provide continuing education and training for indi-
15 viduals carrying out activities pursuant to such
16 award, including training and support for any appli-
17 cable public health entomologists.”;

18 (4) in subsection (f)(1), by striking
19 “\$100,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2019 through
20 2023” and inserting “\$100,000,000 for each of fis-
21 cal years 2026 through 2030”;

22 (5) by redesignating subsections (e) and (f) as
23 subsections (f) and (g), respectively; and

24 (6) inserting after subsection (d) the following:

1 “(e) COORDINATION WITH STRATEGIC NATIONAL
2 STOCKPILE.—The Secretary, acting through the Director
3 of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and the
4 Assistant Secretary for Preparedness and Response, may
5 prepare the Strategic National Stockpile (as defined in
6 section 319F–2) for stockpiling an emergency supply of
7 nonperishable vector-borne disease control products. The
8 Secretary shall incorporate into the national strategy on
9 vector-borne diseases (as defined in section 317U) a strat-
10 egy on how the department will prepare for emergency
11 stockpiling for vector and vector-borne disease control
12 products, including how it will work with manufacturers
13 to ensure timely purchase of control products.”.
