At the end of the bill (before the short title), add the following:

3	America, and the Caribbean; and
4	(E) identify the total amount of funds pro-
5	vided by IOM in the form of debit cards, cash
6	envelopes, account deposits, and any other for-
7	mats; and
8	(2) assess and identify the total amount of
9	funds IOM and UNHCR should repay to the United
10	States Government if IOM and UNHCR have used
11	funds provided under the programs identified in
12	paragraph (1)(A) to facilitate mass migration to the
13	United States southwest border.
