

**AMENDMENT TO**  
**RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 116–19**  
**OFFERED BY MR. GALLEGO OF ARIZONA**

At the end of subtitle B of title V, add the following  
new section:

1 **SEC. 520. REPORT ON NATIONAL GUARD AND UNITED**  
2 **STATES NORTHERN COMMAND CAPACITY TO**  
3 **MEET HOMELAND DEFENSE AND SECURITY**  
4 **INCIDENTS.**

5 Not later than September 30, 2020, the Chief of the  
6 National Guard Bureau shall, in consultation with the  
7 Commander of United States Northern Command, submit  
8 to the congressional defense committees a report setting  
9 forth the following:

10 (1) A clarification of the roles and missions,  
11 structure, capabilities, and training of the National  
12 Guard and the United States Northern Command,  
13 and an identification of emerging gaps and shortfalls  
14 in light of current homeland security threats to our  
15 country.

16 (2) A list of the resources that each State and  
17 Territory National Guard has at its disposal that  
18 are available to respond to a homeland defense or

1 security incident, with particular focus on a multi-  
2 State electromagnetic pulse event.

3 (3) The readiness and resourcing status of  
4 forces listed pursuant to paragraph (2).

5 (4) The current strengths and areas of improve-  
6 ment in working with State and Federal interagency  
7 partners.

8 (5) The current assessments that address Na-  
9 tional Guard readiness and resourcing of regular  
10 United States Northern Command forces postured  
11 to respond to homeland defense and security inci-  
12 dents.

13 (6) A roadmap to 2040 that addresses readi-  
14 ness across the spectrum of long-range emerging  
15 threats facing the United States.
