

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT TO THE  
SENATE AMENDMENT TO H.R. 644  
OFFERED BY MR. NOLAN OF MINNESOTA**

Add at the end the following:

1           **TITLE X—HUMANITARIAN**  
2           **FIREFIGHTER RELIEF ACT**

3   **SEC. 1001. SHORT TITLE.**

4           This title may be cited as the “Humanitarian Fire-  
5 fighter Relief Act”.

6   **SEC. 1002. AMENDMENTS TO THE TARIFF ACT OF 1930.**

7           (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 322(b) of the Tariff Act  
8 of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1322(b)) is amended—

9                   (1) in paragraph (3), by striking “, and” and  
10                   inserting a semicolon;

11                   (2) in paragraph (4), by striking the period at  
12                   the end and inserting “, and”;

13                   (3) by inserting after paragraph (4) the fol-  
14                   lowing new paragraph:

15                           “(5) donated fire-fighting and rescue and relief  
16                           equipment and supplies imported by or on behalf of  
17                           a qualified nonprofit organization for purposes of in-  
18                           spection of such equipment and supplies and the  
19                           subsequent donation and export of such equipment

1 and supplies to countries and organizations in need,  
 2 as determined by the Secretary of the Treasury.”;  
 3 and

4 (4) by adding at the end the following new sen-  
 5 tence: “A qualified nonprofit organization referred to  
 6 in paragraph (5) is an organization that is described  
 7 in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of  
 8 1986 and exempt from tax under section 501(a) of  
 9 such Code.”.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
 11 this section apply to articles entered, or withdrawn from  
 12 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
 13 the date of the enactment of this Act.

14 **SEC. 1003. AMENDMENTS TO THE HARMONIZED TARIFF**  
 15 **SCHEDULE OF THE UNITED STATES.**

16 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter X of chapter 98 of the  
 17 Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
 18 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
 19 new heading:

“ 9810.00.98	Donated fire-fighting and rescue and relief equipment and supplies imported under the terms of U.S. note 7 to this subchapter .....	Free	Free	”.

20 (b) AMENDMENTS TO U.S. NOTES.—Subchapter X of  
 21 chapter 98 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the  
 22 United States is amended—

1           (1) in U.S. Note 1 to such subchapter, by strik-  
2           ing “and 9810.00.95” and inserting “, 9810.00.95  
3           and 9810.00.98”; and

4           (2) by adding at the end of the U.S. Notes to  
5           such subchapter the following new U.S. Note:

6           “7. For purposes of heading 9810.00.98, goods may  
7           be imported under such heading, under the terms of sec-  
8           tion 322 of the Tariff Act of 1930 and regulations issued  
9           thereunder, if such goods are imported by or on behalf  
10          of a qualified nonprofit organization described in section  
11          501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and ex-  
12          empt from tax under section 501(a) of such Code.”.

13          (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
14          this section apply to articles entered, or withdrawn from  
15          warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after  
16          the date of the enactment of this Act.
