## AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 115-**70**

## OFFERED BY MR. NOLAN OF MINNESOTA

At the end of subtitle F of title VIII, add the following new section:

1	SEC. 8 SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING STEEL PRO-
2	DUCED IN THE UNITED STATES.
3	(a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:
4	(1) Frequent surges in unfairly trade steel im-
5	ports have materially injured the iron ore and steel
6	industries in the United States, putting our national,
7	economic, and energy security at risk.
8	(2) High-quality American steel products are
9	vital to the success of the United States military and
10	are used in a variety of applications from aircraft
11	carriers to armor plate for tanks as well as critical
12	energy infrastructure like the electrical grid and en-
13	ergy pipelines.
14	(3) Domestic producers of defense-related steel
15	products are dependent on the overall financial
16	health of the iron ore and steel industries in the
17	United States.

1	(4) The loss of a strong domestic iron ore and
2	steel industry would make the United States dan-
3	gerously dependent upon foreign sources of steel,
4	such as China.
5	(b) Sense of Congress.—It is the sense of Con-
6	gress that a strong domestic iron ore and steel industry
7	is vital to the national security of the United States.
