Page 1348, insert after line 23 the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 **SEC. 5806. REPORTS ON SUBSTANCE ABUSE IN THE ARMED**
2 **FORCES.**

3 (a) INSPECTOR GENERAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF
4 DEFENSE.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the
5 enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Army, the Sec-
6 retary of the Navy, the Secretary of the Air Force, and
7 the Commandant of the Marine Corp shall each submit
8 to the Committees on Armed Services of the Senate and
9 of the House of Representatives a report on substance
10 abuse disorder treatment concerns related to service mem-
11 bers and their dependents.

12 (b) COMPTROLLER GENERAL OF THE UNITED
13 STATES.—Not later than 180 days after the date of the
14 enactment of this Act, the Secretary of the Army, the Sec-
15 retary of the Navy, the Secretary of the Air Force, and
16 the Commandant of the Marine Corp shall submit to Con-
17 gress a report regarding the use of substance abuse dis-
18 order treatment programs located at or around each in-

1 stallation. The report shall detail the number of service
2 members and dependents that are referred to treatment
3 programs, either residential or outpatient, and either in-
4 ternal or contracted, the absence of treatment capabilities
5 within an installation or grouping of military installations,
6 and the costs associated with sending service members or
7 their dependents away from the immediate area for sub-
8 stance use disorder treatment. The report shall also set
9 forth how the individual branches of the Armed Forces
10 are incorporating substance abuse disorder treatment into
11 mental health services both internal and contracted.
