At the end of subtitle A of title XVII, add the following new section:

1 SEC. 17 . UNITED STATES ABOLITION OF NUCLEAR 2 WEAPONS AND CONVERSION OF RESOURCES 3 TO ENERGY AND ECONOMIC PURPOSES. 4 (a) SENSE OF CONGRESS.—It is the sense of Congress that the United States should provide leadership 5 by— 6 7 (1) signing the Treaty on the Prohibition of 8 Nuclear Weapons; and 9 (2) ratifying such treaty when it is clear that 10 ratification will result in— 11 (A) the dismantlement and elimination of 12 all nuclear weapons in every country; and 13 (B) strict and effective international con-14 trol of such dismantlement and elimination. 15 (b) REDIRECTION OF RESOURCES.—Beginning on the date on which the President certifies to Congress that 16 all countries possessing nuclear weapons have begun the 17

verifiable and irreversible elimination of such weapons
 under the Treaty on the Prohibition of Nuclear Weapons,
 the United States shall redirect resources that are being
 used for nuclear weapons programs to be used for—

5 (1) purposes related to addressing the climate
6 crisis, including through the development and de7 ployment of clean, renewable energy sources, by con8 verting all nuclear weapons industry processes,
9 plants, and programs for such purposes and by re10 training nuclear industry employees;

(2) addressing human and infrastructure needs,
such as health care, housing, education, agriculture,
and environmental restoration, including long-term
radioactive waste monitoring; and

(3) actively promote policies to induce all other
countries to join in the commitments referred to in
paragraphs (1) and (2) to create a more peaceful
and secure world.
