At the end of title LII, insert the following:

1 **SEC. 52__ . REPORTS ON RECOMMENDATIONS OF NA-**
2 **TIONAL SECURITY COMMISSION ON ARTIFI-**
3 **CIAL INTELLIGENCE REGARDING DEPART-**
4 **MENT OF DEFENSE.**

5 (a) **REPORTS REQUIRED.**—Not later than one year
6 after the date of the enactment of this Act, and one year
7 thereafter, the Secretary of Defense shall submit to the
8 congressional defense committees a report on the rec-
9 ommendations made by the National Security Commission
10 on Artificial Intelligence with respect to the Department
11 of Defense. Each such report shall include—

12 (1) for each such recommendation, a determina-
13 tion of whether the Secretary of Defense intends to
14 implement the recommendation;

15 (2) in the case of a recommendation the Sec-
16 retary intends to implement, the intended timeline
17 for implementation, a description of any additional
18 resources or authorities required for such implemen-
19 tation, and the plan for such implementation;

1 (3) in the case of a recommendation the Sec-
2 retary determines is not advisable or feasible, the
3 analysis and justification of the Secretary in making
4 that determination; and

5 (4) in the case of a recommendation the Sec-
6 retary determines the Department is already imple-
7 menting through a separate line of effort, the anal-
8 ysis and justification of the Secretary in making
9 that determination.

10 (b) BRIEFINGS.— Not less frequently than twice each
11 year during the two-year period beginning on the date of
12 the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense shall
13 provide to the congressional defense committees briefings
14 on the progress of the Secretary in analyzing and imple-
15 menting the recommendations made by the National Secu-
16 rity Commission on Artificial Intelligence with respect to
17 the Department of Defense.

18 (c) BUDGET MATERIALS.—The Secretary of Defense
19 shall include in the annual budget submission of the Presi-
20 dent under section 1105(a) of title 31, United States
21 Code, for each of fiscal years 2023 and 2024, a report
22 listing the funding and programs of the Department of
23 Defense that advance the recommendations of the Na-
24 tional Security Commission on Artificial Intelligence.
