

AMENDMENT TO RULES COMMITTEE PRINT 118-
15
OFFERED BY MR. NUNN OF IOWA

Add at the end of the bill the following:

1 **SEC. 3. INCLUSION ON CBP PORTAL OF INFORMATION RE-**
2 **LATED TO CERTAIN ENCOUNTERS ON FED-**
3 **ERAL LANDS.**

4 (a) INCLUSION OF INFORMATION ON PORTAL.—The
5 Director of U.S. Customs and Border Protection shall in-
6 clude on U.S. Customs and Border Protection Public Data
7 Portal the following:

8 (1) Information and statistics related to en-
9 counters with aliens who are nationals of special in-
10 terest countries on any land under the administra-
11 tive jurisdiction of the Federal land management
12 agencies, including through leases, contracts, or
13 agreements.

14 (2) Information and statistics related to en-
15 counters with aliens who are identified in the ter-
16 rorist screening database, and any terrorist organi-
17 zations with which such aliens are affiliated.

18 (b) INFORMATION SHARING.—On an ongoing basis,
19 the Director of U.S. Customs and Border Protection shall

1 provide to the Director of the Federal Bureau of Inves-
2 tigation the information described in subsection (a), along
3 with any additional information related to the aliens de-
4 scribed in paragraphs (1) and (2) of subsection (a) that
5 the Director possesses.

6 (c) DEFINITION.—In this section:

7 (1) The term “special interest country” means
8 any country identified as a special interest country
9 in the memorandum from the Chief of U.S. Border
10 Patrol entitled “Arrests of Aliens from Special Inter-
11 est Countries” (November 1, 2004), and any other
12 country so designated by the Secretary of Homeland
13 Security.

14 (2) The term “Federal land management agen-
15 cies” has the meaning given such term in section 2.

16 (3) The term “terrorist screening database”
17 has the meaning given such term in section
18 2101(10) of the Homeland Security Act of 2002 (6
19 U.S.C. 621(10)).
