

**AMENDMENT TO H.R. 9, AS REPORTED**  
**OFFERED BY MR. NEGUSE OF COLORADO**

Page 8, after line 10, insert the following new subsection (and redesignate the subsequent subsection accordingly):

1       (c) EDUCATION AND PUBLIC AWARENESS.—

2           (1) IN GENERAL.—The plan under this section  
3 shall be consistent with Article 12 of the Paris  
4 Agreement, which states “Parties shall cooperate in  
5 taking measures, as appropriate, to enhance climate  
6 change education, training, public awareness, public  
7 participation and public access to information, rec-  
8 ognizing the importance of these steps with respect  
9 to enhancing actions under this Agreement.”.

10          (2) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this  
11 Act may be construed to require or prohibit the  
12 President from including in the plan under this sec-  
13 tion, consistent with the prohibition described in sec-  
14 tion 438 of the General Education Provisions Act  
15 (20 U.S.C. 1232a), recommendations to support  
16 State and local educational agencies, in integrating  
17 instruction on human-caused climate change and the  
18 societal, environmental, and economic effects of such

1 climate change into curricula taught in elementary  
2 and secondary schools under the control of such  
3 State and local educational agencies, in order to  
4 meet the goals and ambitions of the Paris Agree-  
5 ment to ensure climate education and awareness in  
6 schools.
