Amendment to H.R. 1 Offered by Mr. Fitzpatrick of Pennsylvania

At the end of subtitle E of title IX, insert the following (and redesignate the subsequent subtitle and section accordingly):

1 Subtitle F—No Budget, No Pay

2 SEC. 9401. SHORT TITLE.

3 This title may be cited as the "No Budget, No Pay4 Act".

5 SEC. 9402. TIMELY APPROVAL OF CONCURRENT RESOLU6 TION ON THE BUDGET AND THE APPROPRIA7 TIONS BILLS.

8 If both Houses of Congress have not approved a con-9 current resolution on the budget as described under sec-10 tion 301 of the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 632) for a fiscal year before 11 12 October 1 of that fiscal year and have not passed all the regular appropriations bills for the next fiscal year before 13 14 October 1 of that fiscal year, the pay of each Member of Congress may not be paid for each day following that Oc-15 tober 1 until the date on which both Houses of Congress 16

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approve a concurrent resolution on the budget for that fis cal year and all the regular appropriations bills.

3 SEC. 9403. NO PAY WITHOUT CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 4 ON THE BUDGET AND THE APPROPRIATIONS 5 BILLS.

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no funds may be appropriated or otherwise 7 8 be made available from the United States Treasury for 9 the pay of any Member of Congress during any period determined by the Chairpersons of the Committee on the 10 Budget and the Committee on Appropriations of the Sen-11 ate or the Chairpersons of the Committee on the Budget 12 and the Committee on Appropriations of the House of 13 Representatives under section 9404. 14

15 (b) NO RETROACTIVE PAY.—A Member of Congress may not receive pay for any period determined by the 16 17 Chairpersons of the Committee on the Budget and the 18 Committee on Appropriations of the Senate or the Chairpersons of the Committee on the Budget and the Com-19 mittee on Appropriations of the House of Representatives 20 21 under section 9404, at any time after the end of that pe-22 riod.

minations made under 3 paragraphs (2)(A)and 4 (2)(B).DETERMINATIONS.—The Chairpersons of 5 (2)6 the Committee on the Budget and the Committee on 7 Appropriations of the House of Representatives 8 shall— 9 (A) on October 1 of each year, make a de-10 termination of whether Congress is in compli-11 ance with section 9402 and whether Members 12 of the House of Representatives may not be 13 paid under that section; 14 (B) determine the period of days following 15 each October 1 that Members of the House of 16 Representatives may not be paid under section 17 9402; and 18 (C) provide timely certification of the de-19 terminations under subparagraphs (A) and (B) 20 upon request of the Chief Administrative Offi-21 cer of the House of Representatives. 22 SEC. 9405. EFFECTIVE DATE. 23 This title shall take effect on February 1, 2022. 24 SEC. 9406. DEFINITION OF MEMBER OF CONGRESS. 25 In this title, the term "Member of Congress"—

- 1 (1) has the meaning given such term under sec-
- 2 tion 2106 of title 5, United States Code; and
- 3 (2) does not include the Vice President.

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
