[Discussion Draft] Amendment to H.R. 1 Offered by Mr. Fitzpatrick of Pennsylvania

At the end of subtitle E of title IX, insert the following (and redesignate the subsequent subtitle and section accordingly):

Subtitle F—Pay for Members of Congress

3 SEC. 9401. SHORT TITLE.

4 This subtitle may be cited as the "No Work, No Pay5 Act of 2021".

6 SEC. 9402. PROHIBITING PAYING MEMBERS OF CONGRESS
7 DURING GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWNS.

8 (a) RULE FOR THE ONE HUNDRED SEVENTEENTH9 CONGRESS.—

10 (1) HOLDING SALARIES IN ESCROW.—If on any
11 day during a pay period occurring during the One
12 Hundred Seventeenth Congress a Government shut13 down is in effect, the payroll administrator of each
14 House of Congress shall—

15 (A) deposit in an escrow account and ex-16 clude from the payments otherwise required to

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1	be made with respect to that pay period for the
2	compensation of each Member of Congress who
3	serves in that House of Congress an amount
4	equal to the product of—
5	(i) the daily rate of pay of the Mem-
6	ber under section 601(a) of the Legislative
7	Reorganization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C.
8	4501(a)); and
9	(ii) the number of 24-hour periods
10	during the pay period during which the
11	Government shutdown is in effect; and
12	(B) release amounts deposited in an es-
13	crow account under subparagraph (A) to such
14	Member of Congress only upon the expiation of
15	the period described in paragraph (2).
16	(2) PERIOD DESCRIBED.—The period described
17	in this paragraph is the period that—
18	(A) begins on the first day on which the
19	applicable Government shutdown is in effect;
20	and
21	(B) ends on the earlier of—
22	(i) the date on which the applicable
23	Government shutdown is no longer in ef-
24	fect; or

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(ii) the last day of the One Hundred
 Seventeenth Congress.

3 (3)WITHHOLDING AND REMITTANCE \mathbf{OF} 4 AMOUNTS FROM PAYMENTS HELD IN ESCROW.—The 5 payroll administrator of each House of Congress 6 shall provide for the same withholding and remit-7 tance with respect to a payment deposited in an es-8 crow account under paragraph (1) that would apply 9 to the payment if the payment were not subject to 10 paragraph (1).

(4) Release of amounts at the end of 11 12 THE CONGRESS.—In order to ensure that this sub-13 section is carried out in a manner that shall not 14 vary the compensation of Senators or Representa-15 tives in violation of the of the twenty-seventh amend-16 ment to the Constitution of the United States, the 17 payroll administrator of a House of Congress shall 18 release for payment to Members of that House of 19 Congress any amounts remaining in any escrow ac-20 count under this section on the last day of the One 21 Hundred Seventeenth Congress.

(b) SUBSEQUENT CONGRESSES.—On and after the
first day of the One Hundred Eighteenth Congress, if on
any day during a pay period a Government shutdown is
in effect, the payroll administrator of each House of Con-

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gress shall exclude from the payments otherwise required
 to be made with respect to that pay period for the com pensation of each Member of Congress who serves in that
 House of Congress an amount equal to the product of—

- 5 (1) the daily rate of pay of the Member under
 6 section 601(a) of the Legislative Reorganization Act
 7 of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 4501); and
- 8 (2) the number of 24-hour periods during the
 9 pay period during which the Government shutdown
 10 is in effect.

(c) ROLE OF SECRETARY OF THE TREASURY.—The
Secretary of the Treasury shall provide the payroll administrator of each House of Congress with such assistance
as may be necessary to enable the payroll administrator
to carry out this Act.

16 SEC. 9403. DEFINITIONS.

17 In this subtitle:

18 (1) GOVERNMENT SHUTDOWN.—The term
19 "Government shutdown" means a lapse in appro20 priations for 1 or more Federal agencies or depart21 ments as a result of a failure to enact a regular ap22 propriations bill or continuing resolution.

23 (2) MEMBER OF CONGRESS.—The term "Mem24 ber of Congress" means an individual serving in a
25 position covered under subparagraph (A), (B), or

(C) of section $601(a)(1)$ of the Legislative Reorga-
nization Act of 1946 (2 U.S.C. 4501(a)(1)).
(3) PAYROLL ADMINISTRATOR.—The term
"payroll administrator", with respect to a House of
Congress, means—
(A) in the case of the House of Represent-
atives, the Chief Administrative Officer of the
House of Representatives, or an employee of
the Office of the Chief Administrative Officer
who is designated by the Chief Administrative
Officer to carry out this Act; and
(B) in the case of the Senate, the Sec-
retary of the Senate, or an employee of the Of-
fice of the Secretary of the Senate who is des-
ignated by the Secretary to carry out this Act.

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
